AE&E starts year with EUR 85 million contract

Group to supply steam generator for industrial heating plant in Eisenhüttenstadt, Germany

Vienna, 23 January 2009 – the AE&E Group — a subsidiary of the listed A-TEC Industries Group and a leading supplier of thermal power generation and environmental technologies — has extended its recent run of large contract wins into the new year. Austrian subsidiary AE&E Austria has won an order from EnBW Energy Solutions GmbH for a RDF-fired steam generator for the heating plant at Germany's largest corrugated base paper mill, in Eisenhüttenstadt. The contract is worth about EUR 85 million.

“Following record order intake and order backlog in 2008, this contract marks a highly promising start to 2009,” said AE&E Group CEO Georg Gasteiger. Commenting on the technical features of the project, he explained, *“This order involves manufacturing the world's largest RDF-fired circulating fluidised bed boiler (Powerfluid® technology) which will have a steam generation capacity over ten percent above that of comparable plants in Germany.”*

The order awarded to AE&E Austria comprises the engineering design, supply, installation and commissioning of a RDF-fired steam generator, as well as ancillary equipment including the extra light heating oil storage facility and a selective non-catalytic reduction (SNCR) flue gas denitrification unit. The heating plant in Eisenhüttenstadt will have a rated thermal input capacity of 150 MW, and will be fired with refuse derived fuels, coarse and fine rejects (waste materials) and sewage sludge. Handover of the steam generator is expected to take place in the spring of 2011.
