AE&E Group lands major Energy from Waste contract:

- **Delivery of a process train for waste treatment with energy recovery**
- **Contract from Norway worth some EUR 80 million**

Vienna, February 6, 2009 – The AE&E Group GmbH, a subsidiary of A-TEC Industries AG, had yet another opportunity to demonstrate its competence in the domain of Energy from Waste plants: Its Swiss subsidiary Von Roll Inova was commissioned by the municipality of Oslo to build a third train for the Klemetsrud waste treatment facility in Oslo, Norway. The contract is worth about EUR 80 million. Starting in 2011, the new train will process 160,000 metric tons of domestic and commercial waste per year, serving more than 25,000 households with an annual average rating of 10 MW of electrical energy as well as 50 MW of district heat.

“This contract yet again affirms our leadership in the Energy from Waste field: Especially in Norway, our Group member Von Roll Inova ranks among the absolute key players. After completion of the Oslo facility, it will join the plants in Trondheim and Bergen that together use innovative AE&E technology to ecologically treat the waste of Norway’s three largest cities,” said AE&E Group CEO Georg Gasteiger, as he expressed his delight at the new major contract.

The order includes engineering and execution of all process technology elements from combustion and steam generation to flue gas scrubbing. An additional thermal energy recovery loop using heat pumps in the flue gas treatment section maximises the train’s efficiency. The customer has secured options for retrofitting the flue gas treatment equipment of the two existing trains, respectively for the construction of an identical fourth train.

The contract was finalised in view of the competence and experience of the AE&E Group in the domain of turnkey Energy from Waste plants, the economically best concept, and excellent references in Norway.
