AE&E wins order for Chinese coal gasification plant Twelfth Chinese reference extends market leadership

Vienna, 26 January 2010 – AE&E Group — the power generation and environmental technology group that forms the Plant Construction Division of Vienna listed A-TEC Industries (ISIN AT00000ATEC9) — has signed a EUR 13 million contract with Datong Coal Mine Group Company for a coal gasification plant in Datong, China.

Spanish subsidiary Babcock Power España, S.A. will be responsible for the detail engineering, materials procurement, fabrication and delivery to Tianjing seaport of the key internals for the plant, which will produce 600,000 tonnes/year of methanol. Delivery is scheduled for March 2011 and provisional acceptance for March 2012.

The facility will be the 12th coal gasification plant supplied by Babcock Power España to China, and its 19th reference worldwide, reflecting its leadership in this market. The group's ability to offer superior technology and rapid delivery enabled it prevail against lower bids from some competitors.

The contract ensures that Babcock Power España will be working at full capacity throughout 2010.
