Following the introduction of a new organisational structure at the start of 2010, the Group has now launched a uniform visual appearance for all of its subsidiaries. Under the motto “One Group, one Brand”, AE&E unveiled its revamped logo and corporate design at Power-Gen Europe 2010, Europe’s leading power station and energy supply technology fair. From now on all AE&E group companies will feature the initials “AE&E” in their titles, which will require some companies to be renamed. The advantages of the upgrade for customers are clear – the new identity will create an instantly recognisable international brand and help to align the individual companies’ communications activities.

New organisational structure since January 2010

Until 2009 AE&E was organised regionally, but now the organisation structure focuses on products and services, with global management and accountability. Since January 2010 AE&E has had four product divisions: Steam Generators and Plants, Energy from Waste, Air Pollution Control and Combined Cycle Power Plants. International project development and customer communications are managed centrally by Global Sales, allowing AE&E to market its full, broad-based product portfolio from a single source. Service, Global Manufacturing and Engineering Services round off the new structure.
